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## Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+)

Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+) is public low-cost health insurance for certain children and pregnant women. It is for people who earn too much to qualify for Medicaid, but not enough to pay for private health insurance.

### Who Qualifies?

People who:

- Are under 19 years of age or are pregnant
- Are a United States citizen and Colorado resident
- Are an alien or immigrant who has been in the United States for at least five years\*
- Don't have other health insurance

\*Refugees, Deportees, Asylees, Cuban or Haitian entrants and victims of trafficking are exceptions to the five year rule

### Benefits and Services

CHP+ covers:

- Primary Care
- Emergency Care and Urgent Care
- Hospital Services
- Dental Care (for children only)
- Prescriptions
- Immunizations
- Maternity Care (prenatal, delivery and postpartum care)
- Mental/Behavioral Health Care
